Verum expands – and moves to Waalre

After 4 years in the heart of Eindhoven Verum has moved to a new location in Waalre at Laan van Diepenvoorde 32. Verum has an entire building for its own use – to cope with its expansion plans, allow the further development of ASD (Analytical Software Design) and prepare for the launch of the first ASD based product in 2009.

Verum has grown from 9 employees last year to 25 employees today and is aiming to increase this to 35 by the end of this year. The new office in Waalre has a good accessibility. It is directly situated to the A2, exit 33 Waalre/Eindhoven, 5 km to the south of Eindhoven.
