



WELCOME TO THE ASD:MODELVIEWER V5.0.3

The ASD:ModelViewer is an application that allows anyone to view and print model files created for use with the ASD:Suite. The ASD:ModelViewer is free of charge and may be copied and distributed freely.

Instructions on how use the ASD:ModelViewer can be found in the ASD:ModelViewer Guide. This guide also describes software architecture concepts associated with using the ASD:Suite including those related to ASD model building and model checking.

This document contains additional information, updates, known issues and tips not covered in the ASD:ModelViewer documentation.

QUICK START

1. Extract the *Verum ASD ModelViewer 5.0.3.msi* file from the zip file of the same name. Double-click on it to begin the set-up.
2. Follow the set-up instructions. **Note:** The ASD:ModelViewer is compatible with all Microsoft Windows XP and Microsoft Windows 7 systems.
3. Launch the ASD:ModelViewer application.
4. Select **File→Open Model** from the menu. Change to the "*Examples\5.0.3*" directory (usually located in "*My Documents\My ASD Models*").
5. Select the *Alarm.dm* file. This opens in the main window.

You can now begin exploring the different features of the ASD:ModelViewer. See the ASD:ModelViewer Guide for more information on Verum's Analytical Software Design concept and how it is used in sequence based specification models.

KNOWN ISSUES

Installing the ASD:ModelViewer will associate .DM and .IM files with it – taking these file associations away from the ASD:ModelBuilder if it is present on your system. Re-installing the ASD:ModelBuilder will set the .DM and .IM file associations again with it.
